This questionnaire is to be completed either by a member of the Chalcroft EHS Department with a subcontractor or Chalcroft employee or, via request of an individual involved in, or associated with, an incident or event.

The purpose of the questionnaire is to determine the attitude and behaviours that led to the individual taking, or being involved in action which resulted in, or could have led to, an event or incident that caused harm or injury. It may also be utilised where an individual or individuals have been witnessed undertaking non-compliant behaviour or action to determine potential underlying causes.
